As at Monday 18th, we need three umpires for the Saturdays 23rd/30th October. Your assistance would help your fellow Grade umpires who otherwise may have to "go it alone" for the round.

To complete a full complement of umpires for Sunday 31st October, we would like to ask for six umpires to become available to complete the full appointment requirements.

The Selection Committee will be meeting at the end of this week to appoint members to the next round of fixtures for November.

If umpires wish to query their report, it is requested, that umpires are to ring the observer who did the observation and **NOT** Mike Ralston (unless he did the observation himself) as they will be in a better position to assist.

CA Umpire Selection Panel

Cricket Australia has announced that Damien Mealey has been appointed the Chair of the Umpire Selection Panel. Queensland Cricket and the Association passes on their congratulations, this is a great achievement for one of our state's officials to be appointed to this role. Damien has now left his role as the Oueensland Cricket Umpire's Coach.

Former Test umpire Daryl Harper and CA Match Referees Manager Matthew Hall have been appointed to the Umpire Selection Panel also.

Damien started his umpiring career in Queensland Premier Cricket in 2005-06 and was appointed as a member of CA's National Umpire Panel in the 2012-12 season. After three years on the NUP, he served two further years on the Development Panel (now the Supplementary Umpires Panel.

Over the five years from 2012-17, he stood in 17 first class games (all in the Sheffield Shield), 18 List A and 20 T20s, the latter two all being in CA's One Day Cup and Big Bash League series respectively. Other significant games on his record include two Women's One Day Internationals (ODI), five women's Twenty20 Internationals, and two Under-19 ODI's.
