Cricket Australia Umpire Panels

Queensland officials will again fill important roles on and off the field in the coming season of cricket.

Bruce Oxenford and Donovan Koch will share centre stage for differing reasons this summer following the release of the 2021-22 CA National Umpires panels.

The Association's most experienced international umpire, Bruce Oxenford re-joins the CA National Umpire Panel following his decision last year to retire from the ICC Elite Panel of Umpires last season.

Donovan Koch meanwhile has been elevated to the 2021-22 CA International Panel Umpires list for the first time, making him eligible to stand in full international games.

David Taylor continues to be on the Supplementary Umpire Panel.

Bruce called time on a magnificent international career at the end of the 2020-21 season, which was highlighted by standing in a home Test match at the Gabba during January 2021. Following his retirement from the international game, Bruce has resumed duties at CA domestic level and won his fourth Cricket Australia (CA) Umpire Award. During the past season, Bruce even found time to stand in some Grade fixtures and featured in the Darling Downs Bush Bash League.

As for Donovan, he is a former First-Class cricketer from South Africa who played 21 matches at First-Class level and 20 List-A games. He then began his umpiring career in England before moving to Australia. Donovan was appointed to the Supplementary Panel in 2016-17 and then was promoted to the National Umpire Panel in 2019-20. He stood in all CA Senior Men's competitions during last season, as well as in the CommBank Women's Internationals. He brings with him substantial experience at the professional level.

Bruce and Donovan provided Queensland Cricket with a range of online learning tips for aspiring umpires last year which can be found at: https://gldcricket.com.au/get-involved/umpiring-and-scoring/umpire-training-videos. Qld Cricket CEO Terry Svenson acknowledged the exceptional work done by the State's hard-working umpires in congratulating those officials included on the National panels.

"Bruce and Donovan have done wonderful work as individuals on the field, but equally, any of our umpires who have been recognised at national level have also been leading lights off the field where they assist and inspire their colleagues," he said.

CA Match Officials Manager, Sean Easey, said, "We're incredibly lucky to have such outstanding candidates for each of our Umpiring Panels. Donovan is a tremendously talented umpire, and his appointment to the CA International Umpires Panel is just rewards for his consistently excellent performances. "It's also wonderful to welcome Bruce Oxenford back into the CA Umpiring system. Not only is Bruce a world class umpire, but he is committed also to developing young up and coming umpires and the knowledge he brings to our team is a great result for officiating in this country."

Congratulations to Donovan, Bruce and David and all the best for the coming season.
